Essential guide to hosting an amateur boxing show

The following information is a guide and not an actual quotation for running a Boxing Victoria event.

It is designed to give a basic understanding and information to enable a club or organisation to plan and run an event.

General Information

- Boxing Victoria Sanctioning Fees vary from \$2,500 to \$6,000 for registered boxing Victoria Clubs and \$7,000 for non-registered clubs (This is not a set fee, it is dependent on date, time, duration of event and location. Prior to organising the event, please contact Boxing Victoria to ascertain the exact sanctioning cost for your proposed event.
- This fee confirms all officials and supervisors for your event. If the event is over multiple days or in a rural area, then accommodation and travel expenses may be an additional cost.
- Doctor: A qualified doctor must be present for pre & post medical checks of all competitors and stay present ringside for the duration of every bout. A standard day for the doctor is from 10am to 11am for weigh-in and Noon to 5pm for the event, the doctor must be approved by Boxing Victoria. Doctor's costs vary and will be confirmed prior to any booking. The fees vary depending on date, time, duration of event and location.
- Competition Gloves and Headgear will be supplied by Boxing Victoria
- Calibrated scales for weigh-in will be supplied by Boxing Victoria.

- Venue Hire: This is the responsibility of the promoter – if it is a venue that has never been used for a Boxing Victoria event. Then details of the venue must be provided in advance to Boxing Victoria to ensure it is suitable for an event.
- Ring Hire: Any ring used must conform to Boxing Australia guidelines, Boxing Victoria can recommend companies for such a purpose. The approximate price for ring hire is \$1,500 per day.
- All boxers must be registered with their state, have an in date medical and serology report which must be provided during weight-in.
- Boxing Matches – all matches will need to be approved on the day of competition by the Official Supervisor to ensure weight limits, age limits and experience are adhered to. This is confirmed at the completion of the weigh-in time. The safety of the boxers is always the first priority.
- It is recommended that the promotor seeks to schedule at least 20 bouts for a show – the timing for an even generally works out to about 4 bouts per hour.
- The promoter may make matches with the assistance of Boxing Victoria Match Maker, Benny Brizzi. For Masters related bouts the promoter may make matches with the assistance of Boxing Victoria Masters Matchmaker, Igor Pocev.

- Trophies and presentations are the responsibility of the promoter.
- Security for the event is the responsibility of the promoter.
- The promoter will need to engage the services of an MC, photographer and film crew for the event.
- **NOTE:** The camera must be positioned to record all bouts and the field of play for the duration of the event. A copy of the bouts must be supplied to Boxing Victoria at the completion of the event at no cost.

General items to consider before promoting an event

- Recommended numbers of volunteers to run an event is 10
- Reception – entry desk x2 people
- Gloving Table x2 people
- Trophies & Presentations x1 person
- Runners – chasing boxers and ensuring all equipment is returned to the gloving steward x2 people
- Promoters assistant x1 person
- Food and beverages area x2 people
- The field of play area, 2 meters on all sides of the ring to be sectioned off from spectators.
- Tables required for Officials is 6 with 12 Chairs.
- Weigh-in tack about 2 hours to conduct and should be conducted at least 3 hours before the start of the first bout.
- Suitable areas for warm-ups considering the number of contestants
- Food and drink for Officials on completion of the event.

- Sanctioning Fee: \$2,500 to \$7,000
- Ring Hire: \$1,500
- Venue Hire: \$1,500
- Doctor: \$TBA
- Trophies: \$750
- Photographer: \$150
- Film crew \$100
- MC : \$200
- Marketing – Posters : \$250


INCOMING FINANCE

- Ticket sales – average price \$30pp
- 100 spectators = \$3000
- 200 Spectators = \$6000
- 300 spectators = \$9000
